

# ASSISTING INDIVIDUALS IN CRISIS (PEER SUPPORT) & GROUP CRISIS INTERVENTION

APRIL 10-12, 2018

**Critical Concepts Consulting** is pleased to present a Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM) training, Assisting Individuals in Crisis and Group Crisis Intervention, on **April 10-12, 2018**.

This course presents the core elements of a comprehensive, systematic and multi-component crisis intervention system, and enables participants to understand and perform a wide range of both group and individual crisis intervention services.

Following critical incidents (e.g., the Amtrak derailment, Line of Duty Death, suicide of a coworker, motor vehicle accidents, events involving children, etc.), natural disasters, and/or terrorist activities, personnel may experience a crisis response. Crisis intervention (CISM) is designed to stabilize and mitigate this response and return personnel to duty and adaptive functioning.

This course will benefit personnel in: Emergency Services (Law Enforcement, Fire, EMS, and Dispatch), Disaster Response, Education, Employee Assistance, Healthcare, Mental Health, Military, and Spiritual Care. This training meets the criteria for Peer Support training as defined in RCW 5.60.060.
